1. Tutoring Assistance-Payment made to an approved tutoring service student attending or will attend
Any student grades PK-12th (PK is 4yr old going into K next year).
This service is for students who are currently enrolled in tutoring or will be enrolled in tutoring before February 1st with a tutoring service. Payment for tutoring services will be paid to the approved tutoring company for services rendered. No payments will be made after June 30, 2025.
2. LAPTOP (Technology)-Laptop purchased by the ACE program
Any student grades PK-12th (PK is 4yr old going into K next year).
*The Laptop will be a Dell Latitude 3140 BTX . The item will be the student's property to keep.
A specific # of Laptops will be available-Once the total # of items are selected the option will disappear from the application selections.*
3. iPad (Technology)-iPad purchased by the ACE program
Any student grades PK-12th (PK is 4yr old going into K next year). iPad will be a 10th generation and will come with a case. The item will be the student's property to keep.
A specific # of iPads will be available-Once the total # of items are selected the option will disappear from the application selections.
4. CHROMEBOOK (Technology)-Chromebook purchased by the ACE program
5. **Any student grades PK-12th grade (PK is 4yr old going into K next year).** The Chromebook will be a Dell Chromebook 3110. The item will be the student's property to keep.
A specific # of Chromebooks will be available-Once the total # of items are selected the option will disappear from the application selections.
6. Athletics-ACE MCN Midwest online store link to select items will be sent after we receive proof of enrollment.
Any student grades 5th-12th enrolled in Athletics reflected on their class schedule.
Some of the store options include active gear, clothing, shoes, socks, and sport-specific items (for example: If you are enrolled in baseball during the school day as reflected on your class schedule you will be able to select from those items such as Baseball bats, gloves, and balls, clothing etc.)
7. Gym/PE- ACE MCN Midwest online store link to select items will be sent after we receive proof of enrollment.
Any student grades PK through 4th (PK is 4yr old going into K next year).
Some of the store options are limited options for active wear, basketballs, baseballs, and gym clothes.
8. Band/Choir/Art-Items associated with the students enrolled Fine Arts program
Any student 5th-12th grades enrolled in specific fine arts classes reflected on their class schedule.
Items requested in the past are Trip fees, uniform fees, band instrument or equipment purchases or repairs. All payments are made to the vendor.
9. Literacy-Books-ACE MCN Barnes & Noble online store link to be sent after proof of enrollment received.
Any student grades PK through 12th (PK is 4yr old going into K next year).
A link to the ACE online Barnes and Noble store will be sent to the student to select up to \$500 worth of books and then the ACE program will order and notify the applicant when items are received.
10. Agriculture-Items associated with the students enrolled AG classes
Any student 5th-12th grades enrolled in a school day AG class reflected on their class schedule. (This does not include 4H unless it is during the school day and on the student's schedule).
Assistance with items related to the AG class, Animals, feed, bedding, clippers, show equipment and apparel, welding equipment, and any other supplies needed to participate in the AG class.
11. Concurrent, Career or Vo-Tech Supplies-Items associated with enrolled classes
Any 9th-12th grade student enrolled in College or Technical schools as reflected on their class schedule.
Some examples are: Nursing-Scrubs, stethoscope, shoes, etc; Welding-Helmet, welder, gloves, and other accessories, etc;
12. Other: Any needs that are not represented at the top but are reflected on the class schedule.
Any student (PK-12th) requiring special items to enhance their education.
Some examples are: Printer and supplies, Archery items, cultural Items for Indian Ed Classes, Robotics, E-sports, inclusion items, or Cap & Gown etc.
